

TSD T-Spey Customizing chart (cutting chart)

To make your own personal line, here is some recommendations on how to cut your TSD T-Spey! I always recommend cutting the line at the back when targeting a specific weight.

Extreme Distance / Spey Competition (for 15´ - 17´ rods)

Recommended lengths: Between 25 - 22meters

Approximate weights: 72 - 63grams

Distance fishing on big waters (for 15´ - 17´ rods)

Recommended lengths: Between 22 - 20meters

Approximate weights: 62 - 55grams

Comfortable fishing in mid- to big waters (for 14´6"- 17´ rods)

Recommended lengths: Between 20 – 18meters

Approximate weights: 55 – 49grams

All of the recommendations above is calculated with a 15´ tapered nylon leader. If you wish to fish with poly leaders, please cut 1meter of the tip to get a more balanced front taper and more powerful turnover. The weight of the first meter of the front is approximately 0,5 grams.

Here are my personal ways of cutting the T-Spey line!

15´1 Spey Competition

Length: 22,5 - 22meters

Approximate weight: 63 - 62grams

Distance fishing on big waters (for 15´ - 17´ rods)

Length: 20 - 19meters

Approximate weight: 55 – 52grams

Comfortable fishing in mid- to big waters (for 15´ rods)

Length: 19 - 18meters

Approximate weight: 52 – 49grams

I use this lengths (19-18m) when I fish with poly leaders (9-11´ Intermediate-Sink4). For my "comfortable line" I always cut of 1meter of the front for better turn over power whilst fishing with poly leaders and tube flies.

NOTE!!

Sometime the lines can differ 1-2grams in weight so make sure to weigh your line before cutting it!
